Re: Execution and Implementation of a Curfew and Roving Security;

Attention: Frog Lake First Nation continues to take steps to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in order to protect the members of Frog Lake. Beginning today, April 2, 2020, we will move forward with the implementation of:

-A CURFEW WILL NOW COME INTO AFFECT AS OF APRIL 2, 2020 and will be as follows:

***Monday – Thursday 10pm – 6am**

***Friday – Sunday 8pm – 6am**

-In addition to the curfew, Frog Lake First Nations will also be deploying **Roving Security**. It will be the task of the Roving Security to:

- Record and report any and all traffic activity during the curfew hours,
- To provide a means of over watch to public buildings; and
- To provide a means of over watch through the community while we continue to remain in our homes.

-Reason: Many of our members along with incoming visitors are continuing to take unnecessary risks by travelling out of the area for reasons that are not deemed to be necessary. We remind everyone to please stay in your homes during this time. The only travel considered essential would be to stock up on Groceries or Prescription refills or Emergency medical requirements. Travelling to town for Timmies or out of boredom is not considered to be essential. Please respect the fact that we are doing this to protect everyone in every community, not just our own. If this behavior continues, we will be forced to move into the next phase which would be to close down our borders by setting up check points, closing off all secondary access points coming in and out of Frog Lake.

-Those required to be in transit (ie. Oilfield works, Truckers and other) will not be affected by this curfew but should take into account, if the Nation is to take further steps to protect our borders, that they will be delayed with their job requirements.

In order to assist the Nation with the enforcement of and to ensure these steps are taken correctly to further ensure that the Nation and our people are protected and Good Peace and Order are maintained, Frog Lake Chief and Council have passed two By-Laws:

1. **By-Law 3: Of The Frog Lake First Nations #121 and #122 Being a By-Law to Provide for the Removal and Punishment of Persons Trespassing or Frequenting the Reserve for Prohibited Purposes; and**
2. **By-Law 4: Of The Frog Lake First Nations #121 and #122 A By-Law Governing the Residence of Band Members and Other Persons On The Frog Lake First Nations #121 and #122.**

Frog Lake Chief and Council are asking for your assistance in reducing the spread of COVID-19 by:

- -Keeping any and all travel to the purpose of essential travel;
- -When going out to conduct your essential travel, please try to stay away from major centers such as Edmonton or Calgary. These two areas are hotspots.
- -Take all steps to keep your children and elderly at home while you conduct your essential travel.
- -Ask Family from other locations not to visit at this time. Ask them to stay home as they are putting all at risk.
- -Please teach your children to wash their hands after touching common touch surfaces.
- -Check on your Family and especially your/our Elderly by calling, texting, emailing, or knocking on the door but not going in.
- -AND again please, do not travel if you do not have to. We can't stress this enough.

WE GREATLY APPRECIATE YOUR EFFORTS WITH HELPING OUR NATION REMAIN HEALTHY AND FREE OF ANY CASES WITH IN FROG LAKE. AS THE NUMBER OF COVID-19 CASES INCREASE, SO WILL THE STEPS TAKEN BY THE ADMINISTRATION AND OUR CHIEF AND COUNCIL.
