

Treaty Statement

We, the undersigned, Chiefs of Treaties 6,7 and 8 hereby service **NOTICE** to the state of Canada that we do not consent for the State of Canada to terminate our International Peace and Friendship Treaties with the Imperial Crown of Great Britain. The State of Canada is NOT a party to our International Treaties

In our Peace Treaties, we agreed to share our territories for settlement for the Queen's subjects in exchange for benefits for our peoples for as long as the sun shines, the grass grows and the waters flow. This was in accordance with the Royal Proclamation of 1763. Our peoples did not surrender our territories, our natural resources nor our right of self-determination to the Imperial Crown. Canada has wrongly assumed title to our territories, our natural resources and our right to self-determination without our consent.

Now Canada continues to colonize our peoples through their legislations such as the Land Management Act, the Financial Management Act, the Child Welfare Act and the specific claims policy to terminate our Treaties and not provide the promises of our Treaties.

We do not give our consent for Canada to use the national organizations, specifically the Assembly of First Nations to manipulate and manufacture our consent.

The time has come for Canada to meet with our Rights Holders of our Treaties, our Chiefs, to establish a government-to-government relationship in good faith. We invite you in the spirit of true reconciliation
