Re: Next Ration Delivery Date April 14, 2020 until Completed; Information and Signage added to your Mailbox and Deliveries;

Attention: Important Information Regarding Rations Delivery and Information

Frog Lake First Nations Members,

Please be advised that on **April 14, 2020**, the next Ration Delivery will commence.

Included with these deliveries, as well as adding to those with mailboxes, will be an information package. This package will include the following:

1. Window signage with a description of purpose;
2. If you haven't received one already, an updated copy of the Frog Lake First Nations Emergency Contact Information;
3. A copy of the two posted By-Laws with a notice of the posted Curfew; and
4. A list provided by housing which speaks to some of the steps you can take to limit minor plumbing issues and other steps to reduce house calls.

We want to take this time to remind everyone residing on the Nation to stay in your homes while the deliveries take place. We are planning to reach every home within a 72hr timeframe. We understand that some households have occupants that will be at work during this time. Other than personal emergencies or doctor's appointments or prescription refills, these should be the only reasons for not being home.

If possible, please ensure that someone is home to receive your rations. If this is not possible, please do your best to inform the ECC by either calling the Band Office or by leaving a note on your door to state what time you will be home and you should do everything possible to abide by your posted return time.

Thank you again for your patience during our first time around. We understand that this process is not the smoothest and comes with some confusion and difficulty but it has been put in place for the safety of all of community members. We will continue to improve this process as we move forward.

Again, we remind everyone to please stay in their homes. Every community is working hard to reduce the spread of the COVID-19 Virus and we must contribute to these efforts by remaining at home whenever possible.

On behalf of Frog Lake First Nations Chief and Council and the Administration, we would like take this time to Thank everyone involved in assisting the Nation with providing the essential services required to keep us moving forward and this includes those who are abiding by the suggestions to stay in your homes. You are doing your part to flatten the curve and to allow the Health services industry to address the COVID-19 situation in a manner where their attention can be given to those most in need. We are showing all that Frog Lake First Nations is helping in any way it can.
