TREATY SIX DECLARATION OF AFFIRMATION

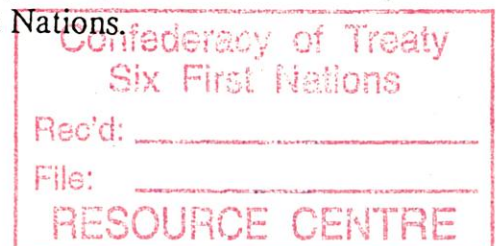
THIS DECLARATION IS AN AFFIRMATION OF TREATY SIX AUTHORITY AND POWERS.


WHEREAS the Treaty Six First Nations are founded upon principles recognizing the supremacy of the Creator, respect for His Creation, the Sacredness of the pipe stem and the oral tradition of our Elders who pass laws from generation to generation;

AND WHEREAS Treaty Six First Nations entered into Treaty Six as separate and independent Nations, based on indigenous laws that are internationally recognized.

IT IS RESOLVED THAT THE TREATY SIX FIRST NATIONS consensually confirm to remain united as a Confederacy of Nations to protect and maintain the spirit and intent of the following principles of Treaty Six:

1. Treaty Six First Nations believe that The Creator, created our people and gave us our land, our culture and our traditional way of life. No man or government can grant or take away what the Creator has given.
2. Treaty Six First Nations acknowledge the historic fact that our forefathers had the authority to enter into Treaty Six with the Imperial Crown of Great Britain.
3. Treaty Six recognizes our Indigenous peoples living in harmony with the Natural Laws of Mother Earth.
4. Treaty Six is a Sacred Trust which cannot be broken. Any change to the Sacred Treaty relationship would need the consent of Treaty Six First Nations.
