(amiskwacîwâskahikan) THE CONFEDERACY OF TREATY NO. 6 CHIEFS EXTEND THEIR CONDOLENCES TO HER ROYAL MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH II ON THE PASSING OF PRINCE PHILLIP

The Confederacy of Treaty No. 6 Chiefs express their deep sorrow and extend their condolences to Her Majesty, the Queen and the Royal Family on the passing of Prince Phillip, the Duke of Edinburgh. The Chiefs of Treaty No. 6 Confederacy recognizes the unique role the Prince played as husband and consort of Queen Elizabeth for more than seven decades. The Chiefs recognize his selfless service during the Second World War and his charitable work in the United Kingdom, the Commonwealth and around the world since his marriage to Her Majesty the Queen in 1947.
